

Confirming your housing situation

1. Bring proof of your tenancy

Current tenancy agreement

▼ I don't have one

If you don't have a current tenancy agreement, please bring a letter from your landlord or your landlord's agent. This letter must be signed by the landlord or agent and show:

1. Landlord or agent's name and address
2. Full address of the rental property
3. Full names of all tenants
4. The date you moved in
5. Current rent payments (including any additional charges and how often you pay)

2. Bring proof of your residency

Recent utility bill for your address (gas, electricity or water)

TV Licence

If you don't have a recent utility bill, please bring **1** of the following:

Current bank or building society statement or account book

Council tax statement

Home or vehicle insurance certificates

Current landline telephone bill

Official letter e.g. from a tax or benefit solicitor

3. Bring proof of rent costs

2 months of bank statements showing your rent payments

If you don't have 2 months of bank statements, please bring **1** of the following:

Recent rent account statements or rent book

Recent rent payment receipts

Rent deposit payment receipts (for new tenancy)
